What part did the “blood of the lamb” ritual of that first Passover play in God’s plan to save the righteous Israelites from death?

Many students are enslaved to vices and have allowed their hearts to be hardened. What ways can we as a school and as teachers better reach these students in dire need of God’s unfailing love?

DISCUSSION: God instituted “Passover” when He commanded the Israelites “to eat the flesh of the lamb that night with unleavened bread” (Exodus 12:8) and to “keep this day as a memorial forever,” (Exodus 12:14) as a sign of both His justice and mercy. How do we keep this memorial today?
